11. Lack of Officials

- 1) To check 'Officials Sign in Sheets' instead of declarations
- 2) Confirmation of the number of officials require by 'The Wessex League'
 - a) 1 Graded Track Judge
 - b) 1 Graded Timekeeper
 - c) 1 Field L2 or Above
 - d) 2 Field L1 or Above
 - e) Proposal by Laura White to have a minimum of a field team of 3, 1x L2 plus only 1 L1
- 3) Proposal by Laura White to give Final Warning to the clubs who have failed to provide enough officials
- 4) Proposal by Laura White to dock team league points from the overall club table, leaving 'Age Group' league points alone, in order to penalise the club and not the athletes
